Gramrajya Vikas Evam Prashikshan Sanstha (GVPS) is a non-profit, non-government development organization committed to improving the lives of disadvantaged communities in Rajasthan, India, utilising an integrated and sustainable approach. It prioritises participation and empowerment of local communities. GVPS evolved out of a grass root level organization in 2002 in the village of Nangal Sherpur in the Karauli district of Rajasthan. The organisation was registered under Rajasthan Society Registration Act, 1958. The organization, committed to improving lives of disadvantaged communities in Rajasthan, India, utilising an integrated and sustainable approach. It prioritises participation and empowerment of marginalized and deprived communities, local communities. GVPS became involved in local efforts to enhance the well-being of communities that have been living in this region amongst these deficits. From its humble beginnings, GVPS today is a rapidly growing organisation supported by numerous donors. It implements specific community-need based programmes to reduce and ultimately eradicate poverty. It also links up environmental issues with human needs. GVPS, with long sustained experience understands that poverty reduction strategy must essentially address all the interlinked developmental issues an impoverished community faces every day. GVPS, thus continues improving the quality of life of the disadvantaged sections of communities living deep within the Rajasthan remote rural, urban and semi-urban operational areas by its relentless sustainable work on varied range of issues like ill health, child rights issues, lack of livelihood opportunities, and protect the environment. 


# Achievements of CHILDHELPLINE 1098

- More than 1650 cases are registered on 1098
- More than 18650 people are aware among 1098(children, women, elderly, PRIs, DLOs, BLOs, etc.)
- more than 54 cases of child marriage were registered.
- More than 127 cases of child labor were registered.
- More than 65 cases of the missing child.
- More than 165 cases of PFA were registered.
- More than 85 cases regarding corona help.
- More than 200 children were regarding the shelter.
- More than 4876 total phone testing were done

# **Girls Education Program, IIMPACT**

There are to 77 learning Centres are being running in Rajasthan by Gramrajya Vikash Evam Prashikshan Sanshtan (GVPS) for slow learner from girls' child to mainstream them in the Government school. Among the 77 learning Centres, 34 learning centres are in Bundi District and 43 learning Centres are in karauli District. In the 77 learning Centres total 2197 girls are enrolled. For joyful learning of the students a library( Partham library) has been found where different colourful books are available for the students. There Audiovisual teaching system is arranged for the student. In that system Laptop and projector screen are used Jodo Gyan kit to teach Mathematics, Barkha series for Hindi, and English, Agastya kit for environmental studies very simply. So the student are attracted to come to their centre and they can also understand easily and can remember for a long days.

In girls education programme total students are 2197 (Bundi – 893, Karauli - 1304). Among them 982 girls from Bundi have been mainstreamed in the Government School.77 Centres Management committee have been formed in 77 villages for monitoring the centres regularly. For the Cognitive development of the girl child, a library has been formed and Information technology is being used in education process. All the teachers (77) are trained regularly for their capacity building on different teaching techniques, TLM preparation, Centre management etc.

GVPS has conducted a SVP (SAFE VILLAGE PROGRAM) in Karauli District of Rajasthan.


Area covered: Karauli Total SVP Conducted: 24

The main objective of this project is to improve the quality of the existing education system develop capacity of the teachers, use joy-full activity-based and learning materials and make a child-friendly environment, To empower to organize (SMC), community mobilize, and Strengthen the community-based organization and To facilitate the community and convergence with different officials to create enabling environment of Along with education. these Quality Education objectives, Program works on the learning gap created by children created by Covid 19 Lockdown.





# Achievements of Quality education program

- GVPS work with Marginalised communitie like: BANJARA, KALBELIYA, BHOPA, RABARI, BAIRWA, KANJAR, KAHAR, etc.
- Reduce the learning gap which arises due to Covid 19 lockdown.
- Increases the use of TLMs in Government School.
- Now 443 students are regular in school.
- Government teacher also use TLMs to teach children.
- Interest of community towards education increases by community awareness.
- 62 New enrolments were there after implementation of QEP.
- Work with the 276 alumina girls.
- 10 SMC are activated in government school

# **GVPS** work in COVID-19

When the pandemic struck and the lockdown was announced like everything GVPS also paused and initially starts working on virtual mode. But it was realised that there is need to reach out to the vulnerable communities-especially women and children also to frontline workers.

- GVPS decided to work in field to reaching the unreached by following COVID- 19 Guidelines.
   GVPS took the task of providing information and educating communities about ways to cope with this Pandemic.
- GVPS also distributed mask, sanitizers, hand wash, dry ration, food packages, sanitary napkins etc to needy persons.
- GVPS also try to link children with education and recreational activities and door to door teaching and by virtual mode.
  - 6360 Mask was distributed in Karauli and Bundi District.
  - 1230 Ration kits were distributed in Karauli and Bundi district.
  - 1262 food packages were distributed in Bundi District.
  - 654 sanitizers were distributed.
  - 178 hand wash were distributed.
  - 3450 women and children were provided milk powder, biscuit, and chocolates.
  - 340 sanitary napkins were distributed to adolescent girls.
  - 132 migrant labourers were listed for linkages with the Government Relief efforts.
  - In 77 villages of Bundi and Karauli GVPS spread awareness about COVID-19 precautions
